Our best chance to eradicate polio is now, says the World Health Organization's polio chief. His focus is on the war-torn Afghanistan and the parched and dusty plains of Pakistan – the last two places on the planet where wild polio still thrives. Even during a pandemic, even as grim realities confront him, O'Leary conveys a sense of optimism about the possibility of finally eradicating polio.

Yet O'Leary's optimism is shaded with a sense of urgency and pragmatism. "There is absolutely no case for complacency here," he says. "What is really important is that we double down on reaching the persistently missed children who are a top priority for our program."

The numbers are extremely encouraging. We've gone over a very bumpy road during the last two years. but we've recorded just two cases this year [as of July 27] – one each in Afghanistan and Pakistan.
