Bill Hinds 1945- 2020



THE BEST THING I EVER DID FOR ROTARY was the first thing. I invited Bill Hinds to a Rotary meeting.

I had set a personal goal of trying to bring in one new member each year, and Bill was my first ask. I didn't know much about Bill except that we had ushered together at church, he was energetic and friendly, and he was a Marine. Bill had retired as a Lt. Colonel after a distinguished career as a Marine aviator, which included commanding the squadron that flew Marine One for Presidents Ford and Carter.

Bill jumped into Rotary with his typical full-assault, total commitment. Bill was one of the best volunteers for any Rotary project, always looking for the next thing that needed doing. He ran the Webb School Scholarship program, which is an enormous undertaking, but one for which Bill had a strong passion. (After the Marine Corps, Bill had joined Sharon as an educator, teaching ROTC to inner-city kids in east Los Angeles.) Bill earned Rotarian of the Year, as well as the Rotary Builder Award, which is one of the rare ones. District Governors give the Rotary Builder award, but not all that often, and then only to Rotarians displaying consistent, significant commitments to build up Rotary. He became a Rotary Foundation Major Donor.
