Dr. Mayer shared details about the very successful Mav Pitch Program. This Maverick Entrepreneur Program and Award Fund was established to encourage UTA students to explore and express their business ideas in a friendly and encouraging environment. The program was launched in fall 2018 and consists of two phases. During Phase I, all UTA students are invited to submit a three-minute video pitch of a new venture idea. These submissions are evaluated and the highest caliber videos are then invited to present a six-minute pitch to a panel of judges who select the ultimate award recipients. The "winners" are then invited to participate in Phase II which involves mentoring, coaching, and access to other resources and the opportunity to participate in a second pitch competition.

Construction for the Center for Entrepreneurship & Economic Innovation is underway at the corner of UTA Blvd and Center Street. 4000 square ft of physical space on campus for all-preneurs to learn, collaborate & share ideas. They hope to foster collaboration, raise visibility and increase awareness of student success in the field of entrepreneurship.

Rotarians are invited to EpIC Mavs by TechFW. This is a free weekly interactive, entrepreneurial seminar series designed for entrepreneurs to learn and grow from each other. It's open to all entrepreneurs in the startup ecosystem. Weekly sessions are held at the University of Texas at Arlington's Startup Lounge. The Startup Lounge is a collision space for entrepreneurs on and off campus. We provide entrepreneurial resources including seminar series and working/meeting spaces. This happens every Thursday. 🍷
