About The Code Academy/Dyslexia School of Houston

After dedicating many years of service to HISD, Founder Tammy Spencer recognized the shortcomings of our public school systems. She understood the struggles many families faced in obtaining timely dyslexia diagnoses, and how numerous students lacked the essential foundation for educational progress. To address these challenges and provide what many of her students have come to know as '*the first good instruction*,' she launched a learning center specifically for students not receiving the education they need through traditional curricula. Thus, The Code Academy was born. Now rebranded as **Dyslexia School of Houston**, the organization is a registered 501(c)(3) educational nonprofit. Its primary goal is to secure funds, enabling students to access world-class dyslexia intervention without placing a financial burden on their families. Additionally, the organization is dedicated to raising awareness of dyslexia within the community and beyond.

About the Rotary Club of West U (Houston)

The Rotary Club of West U was founded in 1995. From its first day it has been a vibrant and dynamic service organization made up of people with a passion for service.

The Club organizes two major fundraisers each year, one being the annual golf tournament and another the flag program that launches 1,700 flags in the West U area on four national holidays. Donations to the flag program fund numerous service projects each year, both locally and internationally.
