

Project Funding Applications - Guidelines and Procedures

It is the intent of the Rotary Development Committee (RDC) to review applications for project funding and then to recommend either one or more projects to the El Campo Rotary Board for approval. Multiple applications will be accepted and the approval process will involve an interview to ensure the project is fully explained and understood by the committee. All applications will be reviewed and each project taken into consideration, however a submitted application does not guarantee funding.

Areas of interest:

The Rotary Development Committee interest is focused primarily on enhancing the quality of life in El Campo, Texas and its surrounding area. The Rotary Club's first priority is to grant funds for needs that are facing our community.

Approval process:

Once the Rotary Development Committee receives applications (Due by September 30th 2015) and performs interviews they will then recommend to the Rotary Board of Directors a project or multiple projects to fund. If, the Rotary Board approves the recommended project (s), it will then be presented to the entire El Campo Rotary Membership for approval.

In order for the project or projects to receive funding, the Rotary Club membership must approve with a majority vote based on the entire membership. If the vote is less than majority of the membership, it does not pass. If the RDC doesn't feel the submitted applications are in the best interest of The El Campo Rotary Club or the project isn't approved by the Rotary Board of Directors, additional applications will be requested from the members.
