Induction

At induction to the club, new members will receive a certificate of membership, a Rotary lapel pin, and a Rotary plastic wallet card. Subsequently, a polo shirt will be ordered to size and color for the member.

Service

The Space Center Rotary Club is a service club, founded on the ideal of service to others. Members are expected to give time to the Club and its projects. Service activities are channeled through the avenues of club service, vocational service, community service, and international service. You are expected to volunteer for club service projects, support worthy causes, and serve on club committees. The success of the club and your success as a Rotarian is directly proportional to your involvement in club activities and by regular attendance.

Attendance

Regular attendance and active involvement is expected of a member who aims to be a good Rotarian. The Space Center Rotary Club, as all Rotary Clubs, encourages attendance of 50% of the meetings each six-month period. Committee meetings or board meetings count as a Space Center Rotary Club meeting.

Rotary International and the Space Center Rotary Club permit you to make-up for a missed meeting by attending the meeting of any other Rotary Club anywhere in the world or on-line. The make-up meeting should be attended fourteen-days prior to or within fourteen-days after missing a club meeting. You are encouraged to attend no less than 30% of your home club's meetings during a six-month period. The club constitution and bylaws provides for the termination of membership for failure to meet attendance requirements.

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

Individual Membership Dues

The Space Center Rotary Club dues are outlined in the bills and fees table, billed annually due on July 1. Dues will be prorated on quarterly basis for the first year of membership. Dues may be paid quarterly.

New Member Cost

New Members pay a one-time fee per the attached schedule. This covers cost of shirt, pin and certificate.

Meals

Meeting meals costs are per the attached dues and fees schedule. A meeting fee is charged with no meal to cover room rental costs. Advance purchase of a 10 meal card can be purchased by cash check or credit card. Meetings at other venues (e.g. Teacher Appreciation) may have different costs.

Rotary Foundation Support–Rotarians support The Rotary Foundation, which is the charitable vehicle for funding of Rotary projects locally, nationally and internationally. You are strongly encouraged to support the Foundation with a tax-deductible donation every year. You will receive Paul Harris Fellow recognition once you attain the qualified contribution level. We strive for new members to attain the Paul Harris Fellow recognition within 3 years or less from first joining the club.

Support of Club Fundraising Initiatives

Members are expected to support fundraising initiatives financially.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

Per the club bylaws, a "family" may consist of parents, spouses, adult children, adult grandchildren, siblings, or a combination thereof of the same family, but the combination shall not include in-laws, aunts, uncles, or cousins. The Family Membership shall be carried on the membership roll in the name of one family adult member and shall have one vote per family and eligibility to hold office.

The Space Center Rotary Club Family dues are outlined in the dues and fees table for additional family members. Dues are billed annually due on July 1. Dues will be prorated on quarterly basis for the first year of membership. Dues may be paid quarterly.

EARLY CAREER MEMBERSHIP

Early Career Members are men and women between the ages of eighteen (18) years and thirty-two (32) years. The Space Center Rotary Club dues are outlined in the dues and

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fees table, billed annually due on July 1. Dues will be prorated on quarterly basis for the first year of membership. Early Career members have all the rights and privileges of an Individual member.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Membership Dues

Corporate membership dues are per the dues and fee table. The dues have two components:

- 1) A portion for Club dues and meals for one member for the year and
- 2) A contribution to the club service account (fundraising account).

Dues are due annually on the anniversary date of joining the club.

New Corporate Member Cost

New corporate members pay a one-time fee per the dues and fees table. This covers cost of shirt, pin and certificate. Additional shirts may be purchased at cost thru the club.

Meals

Corporate members pay for meals in advance in annual dues. Additional attendees meeting meals pay for meals per the dues and fees schedule. A meeting fee is charged with no meal to cover room rental costs. Advance purchase of a 10 meal card can be purchased by cash check or credit card. Meetings at other venues (e.g. Teacher Appreciation) may have different costs.

Rotary Foundation Support

Rotarians support The Rotary Foundation, which is the charitable vehicle for funding of Rotary projects locally, nationally and internationally. The individual designated member will be registered with Rotary International. Contributions to the Rotary Foundation towards Paul Harris designation are not included in the dues and fees.

You are strongly encouraged to support the Foundation with a tax-deductible donation every year. You will receive Paul Harris Fellow recognition once you attain the qualified contribution level. We strive for new members to attain the Paul Harris Fellow recognition within 3 years or less from first joining the club.

Support of Fundraising Initiatives

Members are expected to support fundraising initiatives financially.

Corporate Membership Benefits

The Company will be recognized as a sponsor at meetings and club events and as a major donor at one of the club's annual community fundraisers. The company will be posted as a Corporate Underwriter on the club's website. Company may provide additional donations for other events on a voluntary basis.

The dues and fees outlined below are approved on an annual basis by the Space Center Rotary Club Board of Directors.

Individual Membership annual dues:	\$375	July 1	All members pay.
Annual Luncheon Stipend	\$150	July 1	All members pay. This fee pays for a members estimated cost of the restaurant room charge for the meetings.
Family Membership annual dues:	\$187.50	July 1	Half of individual membership dues
Early Career Dues:	\$187.50	July 1	Age 18 to 32; half of individual dues
Corporate Dues:	\$6000	Anniversary date	Includes \$1000 administrative costs for up to 4 designees. Includes \$5000 contribution to service account.
New Member Incidental Fee	\$60	Joining club	Includes cost of shirt, pin, and certificate
Meeting Meals	\$12	at meeting	A member may chose not to eat lunch at a meeting. Member may purchase a 10 meals card in advance

Note: These fees are adjusted at board discretion. Meal fees and the luncheon stipend can be adjusted by BOD vote. Membership dues are set annually prior to July1. Arrangements can be made with the club treasurer for a member to pay dues quarterly.

Membership fees are adjusted for new members on a quarterly basis per the Space Center Rotary bylaws.
