



Los Altos Rotary: The Galapagos Islands Experience

Itinerary

Based on a minimum of 4 travelers (details to follow)

Cost \$2,850

Does NOT include R/T flight from your location to Guayaquil, park entrance fee (\$100.00)

Dates: October 16 - 25, 2017 (10 days)

- Oct 16: Arrival in Guayaquil, met at airport and transported to the hotel, no meals).
- Oct 17: Tour Iguana Park, Park Historica, and Malecon 2000 with dinner along the Guayas River, (all meals).
- Oct 18: Morning flight to Galapagos; town tour, visit the Interpretation Center, pick up your snorkeling equipment, and head for the beach before dinner. (all meals).
- Oct 19: A day in the highlands: Galapaguera (tortoise breeding center), El Junco Volcano, and Puerto Chino beach, (all meals).
- Oct 20: A day at sea. Snorkeling Leon Dormindo ("Kicker Rock"), beach and shallow snorkel time, touring the sea bird colonies along the way. (all meals).
- Oct 21: Visit the breeding Blue-footed Boobies and giant Frigate Birds on Lobo Island – up close and friendly. Snorkel the secluded channel where sea lion babies wait to play with you. Beach time before returning, (all meals).
- Oct 22: Early flight to Isabela Island – visit Flamingos, Mangroves, Galapaguera, and more. (all meals)
- Oct 23: Visit Las Tintereras – penguin colony and snorkel, island walk with hundreds of baby marine iguanas. Afternoon speedboat to Santa Cruz Island (all meals).
- Oct 24: Highlands of Santa Cruz – visit giant tortoises in the wild, lava tunnels, the "twin craters," and Scalesia forest. (B,L provided - special farewell dinner option)
- Oct 25: Cross the island and the channel to Baltra Island for your flight back to Guayaquil. Flight home that night. (breakfast provided, lunch on plane)
