

LARC Sponsor Checklist

To help new members succeed, please check off the following items within the first two months after they attend their first Rotary meeting.

1. Invite prospective member to a meeting as guest of the club. (3 times total)

2. Be present when candidate receives their Red Badge. Share with candidate what being a Red Badger means, and why it is important.

3. Introduce Candidate to minimum of 12 people within first 3 meetings,

4. Set up a meeting with Red Badger to discuss:
 - Their interests and hobbies and possible committee placement.
 - Give a brief overview of your history with LARC.
 - Provide brief outline of our organization at the local, District and International level.
 - Share financial obligations of membership including a description of the "Kick Out Meeting".
 - Briefly describe purpose and goal of the Rotary Foundation
 - All members support Art in the Park by taking a minimum of two shifts. This is in addition to their Red Badge Project.
 - Instruction on how to use Club Runner and how to sign up for events.

5. Check in with your candidate periodically to answer questions and to make sure they are feeling comfortable.

6. Be present when they graduate to Blue Badge! Good job, you made it!
