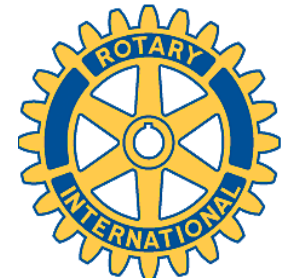
Mineral Wells Rotary Club
