
Foundation Jackpot

telephone "reunions†for 32 years. "Since our trip to District 320 in India in 1978, that Rotary district has become eight new districts. The city of Madras (now Chennai) had 4 Rotary clubs then, and now has 80 clubs and is a district of its own. I was only 40 years old and had not even become district governor when I led the team to India. No doubt, the trip encouraged me to become a district governor because I was placed with outstanding future governors of India and we went through the process together.
