**Well, as the featured Four Peaks Rotarian of the month,** let me get right to the issues of "Why I Joined Rotary."

I moved to Arizona in 1997 and joined a golf league as quick as I could. I was in a foursome with Dr. Brian Swanson and he suggested that I attend a Rotary meeting to meet new people. I joined in early 1998.

I've been a member for over 20 years. After I was a member for a couple of months, Dick Bauer (who was then the Sergeant at Arms) suggested that I should consider taking over the position. Dick said that all I had to do was get to the meeting around 6:50 am, take attendance and that's it. Little did I know that year after year my position involved much more than that.
