He discussed a three step process: 1) identify a potential member; 2) give them the "elevator speech" about being a Rotarian, its expectations and benefits; and 3) invite them to a meeting.

Chandler Horizon Rotary has a process that any prospective member must attend three meetings before filling out an application. The rest of the process will take care of itself.

Jim talked about The Rotary Foundation and what it does to help people in need around the world. He noted the company of his son Brent, a former CHRC president now living in Canton, Ohio, provides bacon to restaurants like Wendy's and Denny's, recently provided bacon to people enduring the wild fires in California.

Jim told us about amounts that were donated to various organizations in the last year, including more than \$500 million to PolioPlus, and also the Rotary Peace Centers, Habitat for Humanity and grants.
