Retired U.S. Army Colonel Chandra Roberts Presents Her Classification Talk

New member Chandra Roberts gave her Classification Talk last week. Since she is a retired colonel from the U.S. Army, it was more like her Story to Tell.

She grew up in Silver City, New Mexico, with little interest in the military. Her father's parents emigrated from China and her mother was from Sydney, Australia. Chandra visited the Air Force Academy at 14 and fell in love.

She became the first woman from Grant County, New Mexico, to be appointed to West Point. She received a phone call from a crusty, veteran general informing her of her appointment.

Chandra received a Bachelor of Science degree in geography, graduated from West Point and received a regular Army commission in the Ordnance Corps. She also has earned a Masters Degree in Public Administration from UNLV and a Masters in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College.

Typical of a military family, Chandra served in many areas around the world, especially so since her husband also was in the military. They have served in countries like Germany, Iraq and Kuwait, the latter of which she described as being miserably hot and dusty in the summertime. She said she liked Germany.

When Chandra's tour of duty was up, she joined the Army reserves. She spent 36 years in the armed forces. She was deployed several times, again to many parts of the world.

She relayed many of her experiences down through the years. She also received many awards, too numerous to mention here. They include :

- Meritrous Service medal (with 4 Oak Leaf Cluster);
- Army Commendation Medal (with 1 Oak Leaf Cluster);

 - National Defense Service Medal;
 - Global War on Terrorism Service Medal;
 - Armed Forces Reserve Medal;

 - Parachutist Badge, among many others.

She was able to go back to Germany and also served at Ft. Bliss toward the end of her career.
