Ron shared a sponsor gift bag that will be given to each participant. James Caskey displayed a gift bag that will be used as a raffle prize.

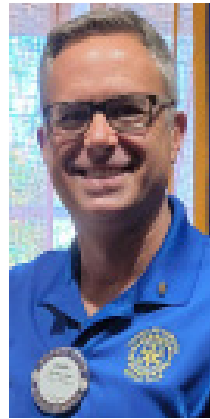
We have a few fairly large items for the raffle and it is hoped we can gather a few more. Let Ron know if you have any ideas.

Chandler Horizon Board Discusses Variety of Topics

The Chandler Horizon Rotary Club board of directors held its regular monthly meeting Monday, led by President Chuck Ertl.

The board approved the application for membership of Jonathon Downs. His classification is Financial Advisor. His sponsor is Will Coakley. President Chuck will send out the application to members to see if there are any objections.

We have been approached by the Chandler Club to see if we would be willing to sponsor one or two students to attend RYLA. Funds have been set aside for Chandler Horizon to send two students from Basha High School, but due to an apparent lack of interest, no one from Basha will attend.

There was discussion about whether we should use our funds to support an applicant from another club. One side said the money has been allocated and should be used. The other side said we can use the money to support another student. The issue will be discussed by the Foundation board that will make a final decision.

Rotary events, including the For Our City Chandler project that will take place March 22 and 29 when we first prepare and a week later paint a house in Chandler.

President Chuck also discussed the District Conference May 1-4 at We-Ko-Pa at Ft. McDowell.

The April meeting has been moved to Monday, April 21, at 6:50 a.m.. This will be a joint meeting with the Foundation board to determine the amount of money that will be donated to which organizations as a result of our annual golf event.
