### Program

Director Katie Dolmage brought us up-to-date on the Chandler CARE Center, a school-based family resource center providing access to medical, dental, counseling and social services, mostly free of charge. It was founded in 1995.

It was funded by bonds starting in 2010 and received its 501(c)(3) status in 2016. It is located at 777 East Galveston Street in Chandler. Katie has been involved since 2012.

They provide clinics for children from households that do not have access to medical and dental care. That includes an immunization clinic. They also have a Diaper Bank.

They also provide food for multi-generational households.

They support both kids and their parents. They also provide family crisis care assistance. And they provide volunteer income tax assistance.

Katie said they receive their clientele primarily through word of mouth. She said they served 3,500 kids last year. The CARE Center is celebrating its 30th anniversary this year. A special celebration is being planned.

They stage several special events throughout the year. The Saturday before Thanksgiving they provide food boxes that serve 400-500 families.

They also hold a special event with the Chandler Fire Department in December.

Their primary funding comes through grants. They also are eligible for the Arizona Income Tax Credit program.
