Rotary logo. Of that cost, \$17 will be returned to District 5495.

She talked about the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards, or RYLA, and said she hoped we will continue to support that program.

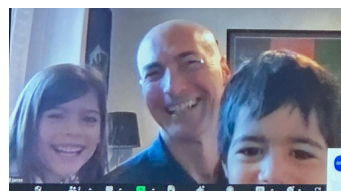
She talked about PolioPlus. She noted that with all the upheaval in the Middle East, particularly in Gaza, a cease fire was called one day so that the polio immunization drops could be administered. Four new cases of polio have been reported. She hopes we will support End Polio Now and drink what is called Iron Lung Lager, a brew that was developed during PDG Larry Horton's term of office. She offered to supply CHRC with cases of the beer to be auctioned off.

She talked about membership, noting that District 5495 has lost 171 members in the last year and is down to 1,850 at present. She hopes each club will add two new members this year.

She told us she is very interested in supporting The Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona and also the Micro Credit program, that enables people in low income areas to pro-

duce and sell products to better their lives and those around them.

President Chuck Ertl thanked Governor Michelle for her service and presented her a \$200 check for the Roger Bonngard Memorial Fund in support of The Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona.
