Chandler Horizon Presents \$2,000 Grant to Chandler Unified School District

The Chandler Horizon Rotary Club applied for a district grant to assist with providing supplies for students in self-contained classrooms.

James Caskey introduced Wendy Umbrianna who is director of the Treblemakers, a girls singing group from Chandler High School, who made their annual visit to Chandler Horizon Rotary. They entertained us with songs of the season.

They started with a stirring rendition of "The Star Spangled Banner" that got our blood moving.

"Jingle Bell Rock" was their first holiday offering. They presented their usual lyric twists and choreography with each number.

Next on the bill was their sentimenteal version of the classic "White Christmas."

They wrapped us their all-too-brief session with their traditional version of "Winter Wonderland" which they have turned into "Zona Wonderland" with lyrics fitting for our state.

The Treblemakers participated in competitive events as well as The Tumbleweed Tree Lighting ceremony in downtown Chandler on December 7 and the annual winter concert at the Chandler Center for the Arts this past Monday.

Once again they brightened our holiday season and we appreciate their appearance. We hope it will continue. James Caskey presented a \$200 check to Wendy to support their efforts.

As you know, the For Our City Chandler Operation Backpack assists those students in the Chandler Unified School District with grade appropriate backpacks for the new school year. Unfortunately, differently-abled students usually have no need for backpacks but are in need of items like weighted vests and sensory tools such as stress balls or fidget spinners to help regulate their energy.
