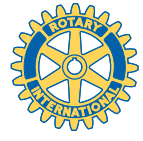

ticularly since we are moving back
to our February/March dates, and
trying to get sponsors before their
budgets are set for next year. Jerry
Turner and Tiffany Jones have been
working on major sponsors.

Greg also told us the contract with
San Marcos is nearly ready with the
only cost change being the addition
of an additional qualifying day. He
said we may farm out the Silent
Auction to a company to run it and
we will share in the proceeds. There
are plans to improve the logistics of
the 50-50 drawing.

Qualifying dates are February
17-19, 23-25 and March 2-3, with
the semifinals, Women's Shootout
Finals and Overall Finals scheduled
for March 4. We probably will have
three work sessions each day of
qualifying. He urged everyone to
block out those dates so they will be
available. We also will seek outside
help to work during qualifying. It is
expected all members will be there
the day of the finals.

There are plans to return to some
sort of an After Party, at which time
prizes will be awarded.
