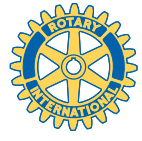

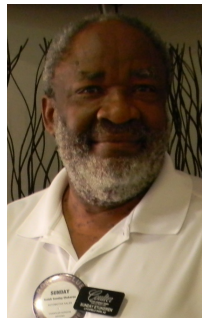

SUNDAY ETUKEREN

Sunday Etukeren brought us up-to-date on his native Nigeria. He started by listing those who are important to him, including friends, family, church and Rotary.

"No one knows where we are going to be born," he said. "God decides."

He told us about his background, noting his mother was 14 when she

was married, 16 when Sunday was born. She had no natal support, was denied schooling, and was sent to marry his dad.

Sunday dreamed of living in the United States. He was one of five out of his class of 300 who was able to come to the U.S. He earned an education at Georgetown University in Washington, D.C., a school built by the U.S. government, that has produced many doctors, scientists and lawyers.

Sunday met and married Edo, and they have four children, two of whom are lawyers and two are pharmacists.

"I love to go back home to see the people we love," he said, even though they have no water, no electricity and little schooling. "Nigeria has oil as well as other natural resources, but no one believes in the law," he said.

Sunday plans a trip back home to Nigeria from December 30 to February 15, primarily to help build water wells. People have to walk 5-10 miles daily to get water. The dry season can last 4-6 months, otherwise there is plenty of water.

Sunday said he plans to retire in 3-4 years, then return to Nigeria to help more. "Money's good if you have it," he said, "but it's all about the heart."

Jim Patmos presided over a Paul Harris Fellow presentation at our last meeting. Jim gave some background on The Rotary Foundation, which collected \$500,000 in its first year. Last year it collected \$100 million. The award was donated posthumously to Todd DeGain, son of Donna Weaver's friend, Glenn DeGain. Todd was riding a skateboard when he was struck and killed by a drunk driver September 14, 2005. Glenn thanked Donna for the award, noting how much it means to him and his family.
