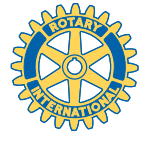

### Board Meeting

The Chandler Horizon Rotary Club board and Foundation board held a combined meeting Tuesday.

President Thersa Clemmons reported the contract with San Marcos Golf Resort has been signed for our 25th annual Hole-in-One Contest.

The board approved purchase of a new tree to replace the Lee Barnes tree at San Marcos Golf Resort. The current tree is in failing health. When the new tree is planted, a plaque will be placed in memory of Lee and all he meant to our club. The Barnes family will pay half the cost of the tree and plaque.

Both boards approved \$25 each for 10 members of our Interact Club to participate in Paint-It-Forward, where the home of a needy family in Chandler will be re-painted. It is hoped our own club members will participate as well. More details will be coming.

The board approved the use of Pay Pal to pay club dues.

Doug Gardner presented a proposal to re-build a home in the Houston area. He will donate cash and will seek donations from others, and he will personally go to the Houston area, possibly with others, to build the home. We hope to work with The Woodlands Rotary Club to complete the project. The Chandler Horizon Rotary Foundation will facilitate the project. All payments will be made through the CHRC Foundation, although there will be no expense involved. Both boards approved the project. More details will be coming.
