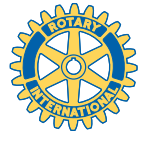

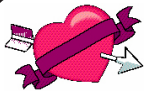

Hole-in-One Contest

Our 25th annual Hole-in-One Contest starts this Saturday, February 17. After a visit to May last year, we're back at our February dates in 2018.

We'll have only one hole in the finals, worth \$100,000. If no one notches a hole-in-one, there will be alternate prizes of \$5,000 for first place, \$2,500 for second and \$1,000 for third. If no one get an ace in the \$20,000 Women's Shootout, the closest to the pin will received \$500.

Any hole-in-one during qualifying will earn a shot in the finals. If there is no hole-in-one on a particular qualifying day, the closest to the pin will earn a shot in the finals. Any shot within 30 inches of the pin in qualifying will earn a shot in the semifinals.

We will have seven daily prizes for the seven closest shots to the pin. We also will have an expanded Silent Auction this year, with many valuable prizes.
