### **Program**

Tyler Vasquez, special events manager for the East Valley Boys & Girls Clubs, brought us up-to-date on that organization. The program was arranged by Soo-San Stevens-Clarke. The Boys & Girls Clubs were started in Hartford, Connecticut, in 1860.

Tyler told us he has served with the Kyrene Corridor Rotary Club as well as the Ahwatukee Kiwanis Club and has been with the Boys & Girls Clubs for 13 years. He noted Arizona is divided into three areas, with units in Phoenix and Scottsdale as well as the East Valley.

The Boys & Girls Clubs partner with schools in their area, providing after school programs in music, sports, arts and crafts, a game room and tech-based programs. They are open until 7 p.m. for those aged 5-12, and until 8 or 9 for those aged 13-18.

"Summer is the best time to help kids," Tyler said. "They are able to be at our facilities all day and not just for a few hours."

He talked about their Leader Program for ages 13-15 and how they worked with the Arizona Cardinals, pointing out the many varied jobs available working for a professional sports team instead of just being a player.

They have a Keystone program for those 14-18 that is similar to a Rotary Interact Club or
