Brenda noted that families today face many challenges: both mom and dad are working, kids feel pressure on many fronts and come to school with problems. Brenda, the counselors and social workers urge the kids to seek help, provide social and emotional support, and help kids feel better about themselves. They also receive help from the Chandler Care Center.

She said they talk to the kids about peer groups, plus work with the kids and their families to try and prevent any problem from becoming a social issue.

"It's not about who you are; it's about what you can do," she said.
