DG Jim Erickson Makes Official Visit to Chandler Horizon Rotary

District Governor Jim Erickson paid his official visit to Chandler Horizon Rotary. He was introduced by Assistant Governor Jay Jones. Both are members of the Superstition Mountain Rotary Club.

Governor Jim, a third generation Rotarian, grew up in Milwaukee, was an Eagle Scout, attended the Air Force Academy, served in the Air Force, earned his MBA from Texas Tech, moved back to Wisconsin, joined the Menominee Falls Rotary Club in 1979 and was president of the club in 1985-86 before moving to the Valley. He was president of the Superstition Mountain club in 2009-10.

Gov. Jim noted his passion is the eradication of polio. He presented a banner for our club's participation in the End Polio Now program. He requested that each club give a minimum of \$1,500 toward PolioPlus this year. His visit also coincided with World Polio Day and United Nations Day.

Unfortunately, the number of cases worldwide increased last year. Twenty cases were reported: 16 in Afghanistan and four in Pakistan. PP Theresa Clemmons presented DG Jim a \$250 check for PolioPlus in appreciation of his service to Rotary.

Gov. Jim told us he has a blog on You Tube that can be reached through his or the district's website. He recommended that our club set up a Rotary Direct account and also that as individuals we set up a My Rotary account with RI.

He pulled out a surf board in hopes we all will attend the District 5495 Conference with the theme "Surfs Up" June 21-22 at the Double Tree Resort by Hilton in Scottsdale. There will be beach volleyball on Friday, a talent show and toga party on Saturday. The emphasis will be more on fun.

He also urged us to attend the District Rotary Foundation Dinner November 10 at the Phoenix Airport Hilton, and reminded us the Leadership Academy will be held the last week in April. He talked about the five Avenues of Service and urged us to work toward receiving the Presidential Citation Award.

He noted that 21 clubs were not represented
