New President Dr. Greg Peterson Tells of his Plans for CGCC

Dr. Greg Peterson, the new president of Chandler Gilbert Community College, told us about his plans for that institution. He was introduced by Chuy Ortiz.

Dr. Peterson took office on July 1. He noted he has a lot of learning to do. He has two brothers who live in the Valley and had visited them when he learned about the CGCC opening.

He noted a community college should be a reflection of the community. Chandler Gilbert has seen growth non-stop. In fact, it may be reaching build-out.

He said that Chandler Gilbert works with both ASU and U-of-A. ASU has reps on campus and U-of-Ahas facilities in Chandler. "We are working on work force support," he said.

There are 10 colleges within the Maricopa Community College district with enrollment of 200,000 plus. There is competition among the schools and he is trying for better coordination.

Chandler Gilbert offers the only aviation program within the Maricopa Community College district. They plan to start a drone system this month. They also will offer training in cyber security.

He hopes to keep the school vibrant within the community by working with the communities and their chambers of commerce. They are working with WAYMO and are looking toward the future. Partnerships with businesses help fund programs

"We hope to create training pathways for students to reach their goals," he said. "We will work with students on financials with the resources we have available."
