Program

Our own PDG Roger Bonngard presented a program entitled, "The Power of a Breath." He noted that at our age (whatever that may happen to be) we need to understand breathing. "None of us was ever taught how to breathe," he said.

He ran us through three tests that would define our breathing habits and help us improve them. Ask Roger for more details.

One of the tests had us hold our breath for as long as we could. The longer we could hold it the better our breathing health.

Roger noted he has two breathing problems: he breathes through his mouth. And several years ago he stopped breathing during one night. He was in a sleeping bag in Mexico and not near any medical facility which caused a bit of panic.

He also had problems at the high altitude of the White Mountains. He was diagnosed with sleep apnea and has been on a CPAP machine for seven years.

He put us through more exercises, showing us how to breathe properly. "You want oxygen to go into your lungs, but not too much," he said. *Please continue reading on page 2*

He urged us to breathe with our mouth closed. That way we will avoid breathing in carbon dioxide, and nitric oxide located in the nasal cavity as well as the stomach well. He said we can take melatonin which will help us sleep.

"Better breathing can improve your quality of life and help you live longer," Roger said.
