Jodie Ostergren Gives Presentation on I-Learn Program at YMCA

Jodie Ostergren brought us up-to-date on the Youth Education program at the Chandler-Gilbert Family YMCA. She was introduced by Jim Patmos.

Jodie worked at YMCAs in Tampa and Miami, Florida before coming to Chandler. She has been here a year-and-a-half. She works with Colleen Buck who is the teacher in the classroom in which we used to meet when we were located at the 'Y'.

Jodie said the YMCA puts Christian principles into practice in spirit, mind and body. Everyone is welcome at the Y. They have scholarship programs for those who need financial help.

The Chandler-Gilbert facility offered 175 free swim lessons last year, including one for an 88-year-old woman who had never swum before because of a fear of water.

There are 16 YMCA locations in the Valley. Renovations were recently made at Chandler-Gilbert, including repainting and the purchase of new laptops.

Chandler-Gilbert is the only Valley facility that offers the I-Learn program. It partners with the Chandler Unified School District. They include students aged 14 up to 22 who have not fit in a "normal" classroom situation. They are referred to the 'Y' by CUSD.

They have capacity for 60 students. Currently 52 are enrolled. They graduated 35 kids last year.
