Names of those killed were read off. They asked for volunteers to read and Soo was called on to read 10 of them. One man's list included his brother who was in one of the towers at the time.

"Taps" was played twice and there were bagpipes.

Each of the 2,996 flags at Tempe Beach Park included the name of a victim. They were arranged alphabetically in three groups: air crews, first responders and those who died in the towers.

Ribbons and flowers were attached to some. Boots were placed at the base of flags who were representing members of the military.

The event was sponsored by the Exchange Club of Tempe.

It was an impressive, almost overwhelming, sight...sad yet inspiring.
