Program

Steven Powell and Jeff Smith told us about C2 Tactical gun ranges. They were introduced by John Leslie.

Steve has a degree in Business Administration and has spent 25 years in the weapons industry. The indoor C2 Tactical facility has been open for seven years and is one of two (Tempe and Scottsdale) in the Valley.

They have people come in from all walks of life, including many women.

Steven and Jeff talked about gun laws, noting the variance in gun laws in different states. Arizona is an open state, meaning citizens can carry a gun openly. Some states require a waiting period of from a few days to a few weeks.

They explained the process in buying a gun. An ATF form has to be filled out and a FBI background check done. "One of three things will happen with your application," Steven said. "It will be approved, delayed or denied." He said that fewer than one percent are denied.

C2 Tactical has about 135 handguns and 38-45 long guns or shotguns. "Most people shoot handguns or shotguns," Steven said.

There was spirited discussion about whether or not gun laws should be more strict in light of the many mass shootings that have happened. "It's hard to legislate the morality of man," Steven said.

Steven and Jeff went into a lengthy discussion about home protection. They recommended that gun owners keep their weapons locked at all times.

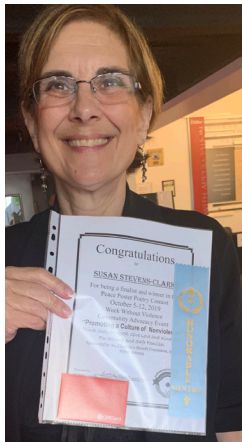
