Program

The Chandler Horizon Rotary Club took a "field trip" to Basha High School last week where we met with the officers of our new Interact Club. Our own David Loutzenheiser, Basha High principal, and Interact club officers welcomed us.

Through a Power Point presentation, David told us Basha has 134 teachers and five administrators, as well as 20 paras and administrative staff, 12 custodians and seven security guards, in addition to other personnel making a total of more than 200 adults on campus. They have 11 departments with 188 different class offerings, broken down into 695 sections.

Basha has 2,585 students, including 266 in sixth through eighth grades in an accelerated middle school program; and 2,319 in high school with a high of 588 in this year's senior class. Student demography includes 67% white, 16% Hispanic/ Latino, 7% Asian, 4% black/African American and 1% American Indian, among a few others. The student body is 51% male, 49% female.

They have 24,990 service projects. Students last year were awarded \$23 million in scholarships. Basha fields 42 athletic teams at all levels involving 600 student athletes. There also are 40 clubs on campus.



1,200 AP tests. Graduation rate is at 75.6% and trending up. The school has an A+ rating.

David introduced Bridgett Burge who is the Interact Club counselor. He also introduced Kylie Britanga, who is President of the Interact Club. Kylie, in turn, introduced other officers of the club who were present: Amaya Nettles, Cadyn Camacho, Dylan Galvez, Ricky Halva and Ryan Lemire.

We not only learned about the school from an up-close-andpersonal perspective, but we also helped the Interact Club dedicate the International Peace Pole that has been erected in the courtyard. Dr. Ruth Tan Lim, who also made a donation toward the Peace Pole, gave some background information.

There are 250,000 Peace Poles in 190 countries. Each of the four sides contains a peace proclamation. Some have English on one side, plus French, Spanish and another language on the other three sides. This pole has two different proclamations in English, with the other two sides printed in Spanish and Japanese.
