Bruce Dransfeldt presented a program entitled, "Gifts and Taxes." He called on other members of the club for assistance.

Bruce asked PDG Roger Bonngard to talk about The Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona. Roger was one of the founders of TRVFA back in 1993. He and Jim Patmos have served on

its board.

Originally, TRVFA gave \$3,000 to each recipient, but as more applications have come in and the foundation's treasury has been reduced, the award has been lowered to \$2,000 per recipient.

The awards are given to people who need support to help get them started or back on their feet. We currently have an applicant in the process. "Money given goes to help a deserving person change their life for the better," Roger said.

Bruce talked about the Arizona Tax Credit program. He handed out forms we can use to make it happen, and urged all of us to take advantage of the program.

PP Theresa Clemmons passed out information about Charitable Reminder Trusts and told us how we can become involved with that program.

Chandler Horizon Rotary Foundation Treasurer Jim Hoenig talked about our own foundation, explaining the difference between club funds and foundation funds. He gave a bit of history of the foundation. When we started the Hole-in-One Contest we didn't have a foundation, but eventually it was determined we should have one.

The toughest task was earning our 501 (c) (3) designation, which we were able to gain in 1989, during Randy Kiesel's term as president. Since then we have earned more than \$700,000 through our Hole-in-One Contest and other fundraisers, most of which has been given back to the community.
