a drive-up location. Amanda Rogers is shown (photo at right) gathering

up sack lunches that will be handed out to those in need at Chandler High School.

Amanda explained that each bag contains both breakfast and lunch items. Each bag also comes with a chocolate milk and a regular milk. They also have juice available on ice, in a cooler.

"We check the temperature (on the cooler) every 15 minutes," she said. "We wash our hands and use sanitizer, not only on the food storage unit but also on all our hand washing stations."

Similar bags have been handed out to various recipients, primarily people who are homebound or with health issues that make them particularly at risk to catch the coronavirus.

Marty also noted that Dara Gibson at AZCEND has reached out. They need volunteer drivers for their Home Delivered Meals (HDM) to Seniors program.
