## Our Why! IMAGINE

There was a ten year old child whose life was shattered after the divorce of their parents. They would no longer be in a loving home but would live for the next five years in a home where abuse, drugs, and watching their mothers suicide attempts became the norm. At the age of 15 they would be kicked out of their home and find them self living with friends. They would become a teen mom and drop out of High school to take care of their child. For years they would struggle to learn how to pay bills, cook or a quire service's that they needed.

Fast Forward 35 years.

That 10 yr old was me. My name is Angelese after the adoption of my 3rd foster child, I had a desire to do more and a love for tiny homes so in Oct 2015

I founded Eagle Pathway.

A non-profit organization that serve's youth and low income single mothers who have experienced foster care and homelessness. Our vision is to create small affordable tiny home communities where these youth can live after aging out of foster care. We believe that by providing affordable housing that is wrapped in love with services, and support we can help change the staggering statistics and prevent youth homelessness.

of commercially sexually exploited children have been involved in the child welfare system 31%

We believe that it is through Christ that Broken Hearts are made whole.


This is why we pair each participant with a church.






