

#### **Guaymas Statistics**

- •44 % live in poverty (live on less than \$4.00 US dollars/day).
- •Healthcare concentrated in large cities.
- Guaymas and nearby communities lack Audiology/ENT services

- Assessment of need for services
- 2. Willingness of local community to support program
- 3. Willingness of Arizonans to financially support program
- 4. Donations of hearing aids, medicine, and other related supplies.
- 5. Availability of volunteers


-Over 5500 individuals seen, ages 6 months-108 years
