Students Apply for Library Card During Registration

Through our partnership, students are issued a library card simply by checking the yes box on their child's enrollment packet.

- Library cards are sent directly to students' homes
- Students given access to all the library amenities
- Pilot with students entering kindergarten 2023 school year. 2024 expand to Kindergarten-3rd Grade



- Literacy tutoring of K-3rd Grade students
- Volunteers receive extensive training in reading instruction
- Students in tutoring are approaching the standards as based on data
- Progress is monitored to build reading fluency, accuracy, and comprehension skills
