





- Rapid Rehousing: 220 families served, 10-12 month financial assistance.
- Step Up to Independence: Growing to 20 units over the next year. Temporary housing owned and maintained by STF in Mesa.
- Eviction Prevention: 3 months of support

- Permanent Supportive Housing: 118
   Units, long term housing for individuals/families.
- ARM: Affordable Rental Movement, which has scattered sites of affordable housing through out Maricopa County. ARM is the landlord. Approximately 150 units.
