Burapaco Mesa Colorada Guajaraí Mochibampo Los Estrados San Juan Colonia Makurawe




Indigenous Peoples of Sonora The Guarijío (Makurawe) are in Yellow

But . . . Beyond Alamos, Many Barriers





- · Great distances from clinics & hospitals
- No public transportation; poor road conditions
- Native Language not Spanish
- · Limited access to cell, electricity, water
- Lack of timely medical treatment
- · Poor stabilization for emergency transport

Sustainable Resources, Partners, and Collaborative Options too!

- · Clinica Almas Integral in Alamos, Sonora
- Social Security Hospitals
- Community Trainees (promotores) in waiting
- Technological advances (ex: Solar power; satellites; telemedicine)
- Rotary in Sonora (ex: Navojoa, Guaymas, Obregon)

And, it all began under a tree!






At the end of this exchange, 4 key objectives and a Global Grant Proposed!






This Year's Show:
