ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER, LIABILITY RELEASE, AND CONFIDENTIALY AGREEMENT

In exchange for volunteering with StreetLightUSA, an Arizona non-profit organization, I represent and agree that:

- 1. I have not been convicted of any crime against a child or of a sexual nature.
- 2. I am aware of the hazards and risk to my person and property associated with serving as a volunteer for StreetLightUSA. Such hazards and risk include, but are not limited to, death or injury by accident, disease, weather conditions, inadequate medical services and supplies, criminal activity, random acts of violence and loss of or damage to personal property. I recognize that such risk has always been associated with servicing in this capacity. Any assignment that I accept as a volunteer will be with full awareness of these risks, and I voluntarily assume all risks of death, injury, and illness associated with such risks, and any damage or loss to my personal property.
- 3. I hereby release and hold harmless StreetLightUSA and its agents, officers, directors, employees, affiliates, successors and assigns, from any liability whatsoever arising as a result of death, injury, or illness that I may suffer as a result of participation in any project or assignment. I further indemnify and hold StreetLightUSA and its respective agents, officers, directors, employees, affiliates, successors and assigns, harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, liabilities, cause of action, and damages that might be asserted by any person whatsoever arising out of or related to my service as a volunteer. I am aware of the hazards and risks to my person associated with volunteer participation with StreetLightUSA, as described above. I further understand that StreetLightUSA may not have any insurance coverage that would apply in the event of my death, injury, or loss or damage to my property that may occur during my participation as a volunteer, and if I desire insurance coverage, I am responsible for obtaining such personal insurance.
- 4. During the course of my service to StreetLightUSA I may be exposed to and have access to proprietary, confidential, sensitive, secret or trade secret information concerning StreetLightUSA, its employees and clients. I understand and acknowledge that StreetLightUSA is placing substantial trust and confidence in me to hold such information confidential, that I have an obligation to do so by virtue of my position as a StreetLightUSA volunteer and that StreetLightUSA has taken reasonable steps to maintain the secrecy and confidentiality of such information concerning StreetLightUSA, its employees and clients. I agree to keep in strictest confidence, during and subsequent to my service to StreetLightUSA, any and all proprietary, confidential, sensitive, secret or trade secret information relating to the services, employees, contractors, donors, volunteers, clients and business affairs of StreetLightUSA, including all information identified as proprietary, confidential, sensitive, secret, a trade secret, or that, from the circumstances, in good faith and good conscience, ought to be treated as proprietary,

confidential, sensitive, secret or a trade secret (all information referred to in this paragraph, whether acquired before or after this date, is collectively referred to as "Confidential Information"). I will not directly or indirectly publish, communicate, divulge, or describe to any unauthorized person, any such Confidential Information during the period of my service to StreetLightUSA or at any time after such service ends. Upon cessation of my service to StreetLightUSA, I shall immediately return or cause to be returned to StreetLightUSA all documents, records and similar compilation of Confidential Information, including copies, whether in the form of paper or electronic media, all keys, and any and all other property belonging to StreetLightUSA. Furthermore, I will not attempt to reproduce such records whether by paper, electronic media, verbally, memory, or otherwise.

5. I agree to abide by all the rules and regulations promulgated by StreetLightUSA.

Appealable 5 Years After Conviction

The following felony offenses are non-appealable if committed within 5 years before the date you apply for a Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card. If you have been convicted of committing, attempting to commit, soliciting or facilitating or conspiring to commit one or more of the crimes in this section within 5 years of applying for a Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card, DPS will deny you a Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card and you WILL NOT be eligible to appeal the denial.

If the conviction was more than 5 years before you apply for a Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card, DPS will deny you a Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card, but you will be eligible to appeal the denial to the Arizona Board of Fingerprinting.
