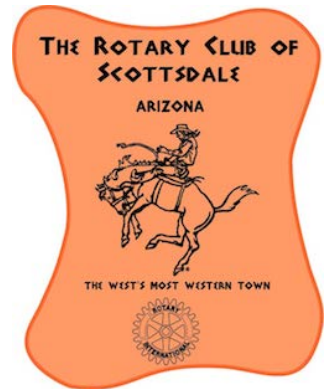

He was a 2007 inductee into the Arizona Tourism Hall of Fame and is active in many charitable and community organizations, including the Fiesta Bowl, where he served as chairman of the board. Holden is chairman of the board of the Greater Phoenix Convention and Visitor’s Bureau and immediate past-president of the Endowment Board of the ASU Walter Cronkite School of Journalism and Mass Communications.

Max's Message

Lili Donnenwirth was born in Russia and adopted by a local single mom as a baby. Life was normal until high school when she began to become internationally aware. The culmination of her high school experience was to become a Rotary Youth Exchange Student to Germany last year. There she followed the Rotary counsel and became fully engulfed with a new family, friends, and the German language.

This experience assisted her acceptance in American University in Washington, DC. She tested out of three semesters of German: saving money and putting her ahead in her studies in the School of International Service.

Because of Rotary, while in Germany, Lily learned to appreciate her Russian roots, gain a new country she loves, discover what being an American is, and decided on her university course work.

The Rotary Club of Scottsdale touches many students through its youth programs. Each member can take pride. The challenge is to keep connected with these young people as they enter their professional life so they are more likely to become future Rotarians.
