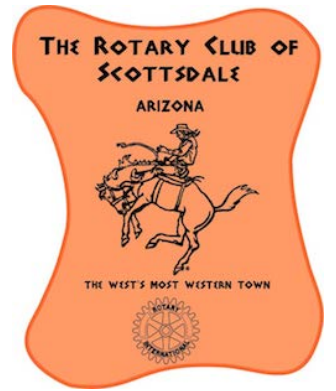

He was elected Sheriff of Maricopa County in 1992 and has introduced many rehabilitative programs including "Hard Knocks High" and ALPHA, an anti-substance-abuse program.

Sheriff Arpaio and his wife Ava have been married for over 56 years and have two children, both residing in the Phoenix area. The Arpaios have four grandchildren.

Further, in addition to the personal satisfaction that comes from giving back to the community, you will learn that Rotarians can be trusted associates for you in many unexpected ways.

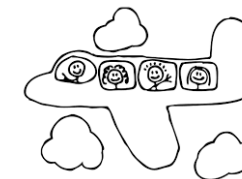
While you are here today and after the meeting, please talk with your host and other Rotarians about this uniqueness of Rotary. We hope you will visit us again.
