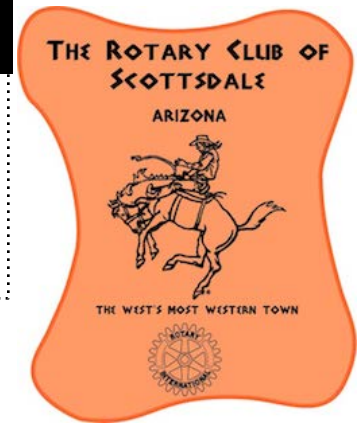

Today's speaker is Senator John McCain. Senator McCain has spent his lifetime in service to America, both in the U.S. Navy and representing the people of Arizona in the U.S. Congress.

As the son and grandson of Navy admirals, the values of duty, honor, and service to country were instilled in John from a very young age. After graduating from the U.S. Naval Academy, John launched a 22-year career as a Naval aviator.

John was first elected to the U.S. House of Representatives from the First District of Arizona on an agenda of limited government and strong foreign policy. After two terms in the House, John was elected to the U.S. Senate in 1986, succeeding legendary Arizona Senator Barry Goldwater.

John has seven children and four grandchildren, and currently lives in Phoenix, Arizona with his wife, Cindy.
