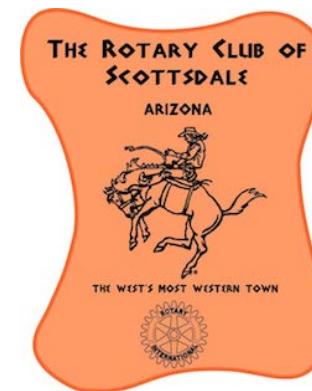

## Today

Our speaker today is Dr. Mark Slater, the Vice President of Research at HonorHealth. Slater has served as vice president for research at HonorHealth and chief executive for the HonorHealth Research Institute since 2008, when the organization was known as Scottsdale Healthcare. The institute accelerates precision-medicine therapies for cancer and cardiovascular disease through early-phase clinical research. Slater has previously served on the medical-school faculty at the University of California, San Diego; held leadership positions at Sharp HealthCare and the Veterans Administration Medical Center in San Diego; and developed medical-research data and consulting businesses.

## Max's Message

A time to be proud to be a Rotarian. In less than three hours on two evenings, Rotarians impacted 57 high school juniors.

Students had four experiences that will influence them for life. They: 1) Completed an application to be a Youth Salute participant, 2) Prepared an essay on current issues facing our country, 3) Received coaching on successful interview techniques, and 4) Had an immediate opportunity to put into practice those interview skills before Rotarians.

The second evening, all 57 high school juniors were formally recognized before a full room of parents, counselors, a principal, and Rotarians. Rotary individually congratulated them for being selected by their school counselors as being leaders in school and community.

It did not end there. Ten were chosen to give a two minute impromptu speech with only seconds to prepare. Four were chosen to represent Arizona at the Town Meeting on Tomorrow in St. Louis this fall. Rotary gave these 57 juniors an experience, skills, and mentoring to prepare them for greater success. Rotarians met young future leaders.
