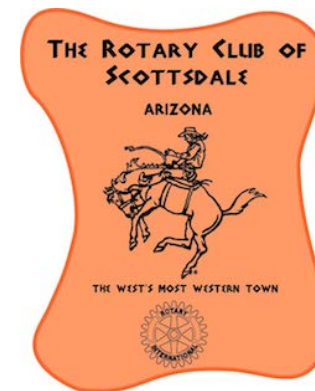

Ms. Klein oversees the \$4 billion Arizona public university enterprise – Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University and the University of Arizona – as well as guides and advises the regents to help inform effective governance. She provides leadership to the Board administration and manages the Enterprise Executive Committee (EEC), comprised of the university presidents. The EEC is responsible for achieving the ambitious 2020 goals outlined in the Board's aggressive strategic plan which calls for significant gains in degree production and research activity, and major reforms in both the instructional delivery model and financing of the university system to support and stimulate Arizona's economy.

Max's Message

At the beginning of this Rotary year, the Rotary Club of Scottsdale board established many stretch goals. During the year, the Club members responded positively to the achievement of those goals and in some cases exceeded them.

The result has been that the Club received a Gold Award from the District for its overall achievement of those goals, and a Silver Award for its membership growth by adding 4 -5 more new members than were lost in the year.
