POLICE TRADING CARDS

THE PURPOSE OF THE POLICE TRADING CARD PROGRAM IS TO PROMOTE A LONG LASTING, POSITIVE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN OUR LOCAL POLICE OFFICERS AND THE YOUTH OF OUR COMMUNITY.

THE PRIMARY GOAL OF THE PROGRAM IS FOR OUR CHILDREN TO DEVELOP A SENSE OF TRUST KNOWING WE ALL LIVE IN A SAFE COMMUNITY WHERE THEY CAN FEEL COMFORTABLE AND CONFIDENT THAT OUR POLICE OFFICERS ARE FRIENDLY AND APPROACHABLE AND ARE ALWAYS WILLING TO BE OF HELP.

HOW IT WORKS

Every police officer will receive a supply of trading cards featuring their picture and biography. Children in kindergarten through eighth grade are the target group. The program will be advertised, parents will be notified and the children will be encouraged to reach out to each individual police officer and ask for their trading card. In doing so, the officers will engage the children in a friendly dialogue promoting a positive relationship. Each time a child meets another officer, their level of trust will grow. The <u>FIRST</u> participant from each school (Riverview, Lakeview, Valleyview and St. Mary's) to collect every trading card will receive a bicycle. <u>SECOND</u> place at each school will receive a Kindle Fire Tablet. THIRD place at each school will receive a tour of the police station and lunch with Chief Chris Wagner. All participants will receive a "Thin Blue Line" wristband. The first prizes will be awarded on July 14th at the Junior Police Academy graduation ceremony. After this date, participants must claim their prize no later than August 31, 2017 which is the end date for the program. Officers may continue to hand out their cards beyond this date but no additional prizes will be awarded.


