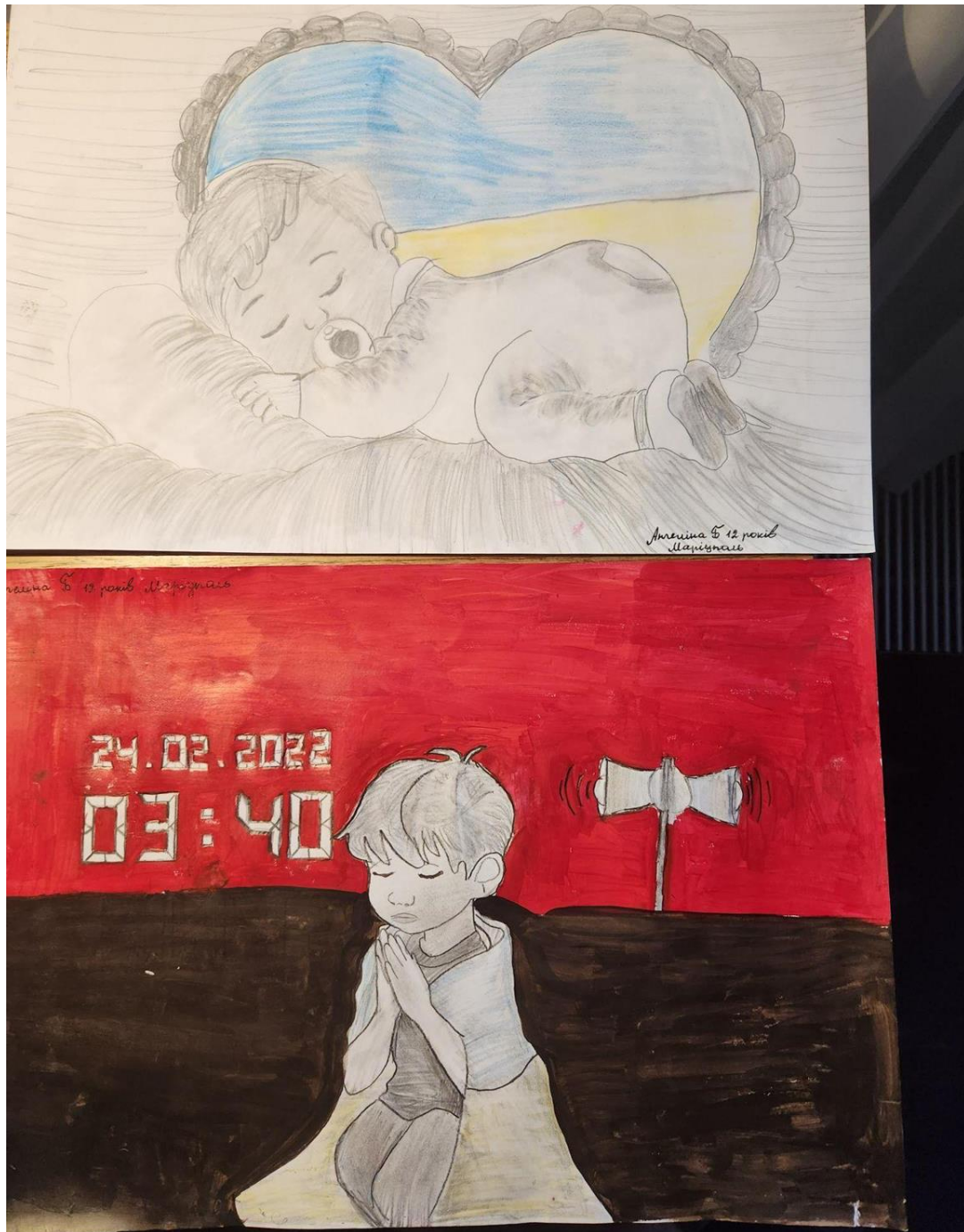

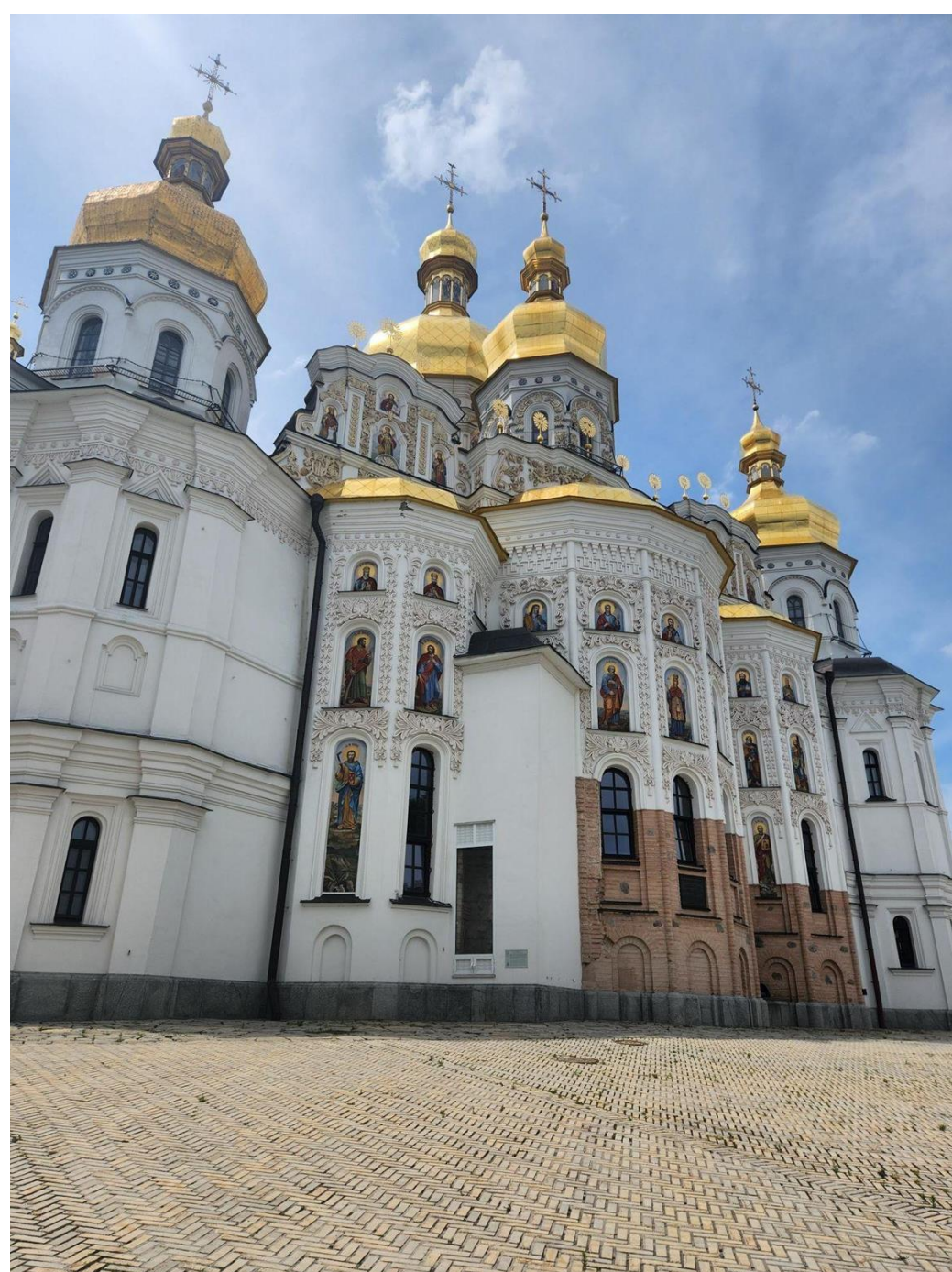

Newark Rotary Exchange with Kyiv Rotaract Professionals and students, focused on war relief, recovery, and humanitarian efforts.

First exchange in Kyiv, July 2023, and surrounding areas impacted by war to conduct a needs assessment on the ground.

Exchange with Civilian Emergency Responders and Ukraine military.

Training and equipment for emergency responders.

NATO workshop for safe demining after conflict: 700 years of work to clear millions of Russian mines in the east.

This is the front line in history for Western Civilization, Democracy, the Rule of Law, and Human Rights, Human Rights, Human Rights.

President Zelensky ranks with Churchill, Ronald Reagan, and Pope John Paul the Great; this is the battle of our time to defeat the forces of tyranny, evil, and defend the sanctity of human life and individual liberty.
