Dan thanked everyone who volunteered at the Chili Open and for their efforts.

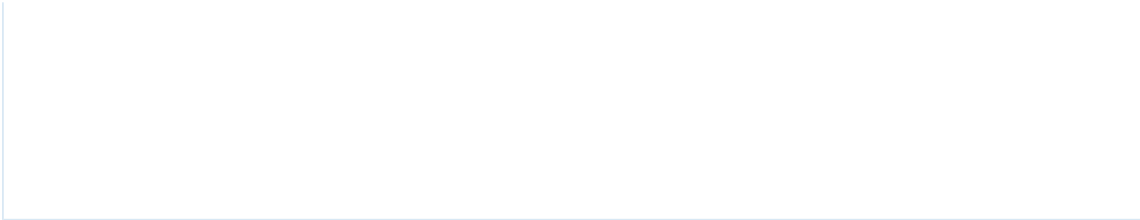
With field hockey completed, Charles is happy for the start of basketball season at SCCC. Note: Weekly updates are promised.
