Rotary offers an opportunity to build lifelong friendships and experience the personal fulfillment of providing volunteer service.

An organization of business and professional leaders, Rotary provides humanitarian service, encourages high ethical standards in all vocations, and builds goodwill and peace in the world.

The world's first service club, Rotary, began with the formation of the Rotary Club of Chicago, Illinois on February 23, 1905.

The club was started by a young lawyer, Paul P. Harris, and three of his friends. They wished to recapture the friendly spirit they had felt among business people in the small towns in which they had lived.

Their weekly meetings "rotated" among their offices, providing the new service club with its name.

Today, Rotary flourishes with some 33,000 clubs and 1.3 million men and women as club members in more than 200 countries, providing community service in virtually every nation in the world.

The Rotary 4-Way Test

The 4-Way Test is a simple but profound statement of things we think, say or do:

1. Is it the **TRUTH**?
2. Is it **FAIR** to all concerned?
3. Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
4. Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

Nutley Rotary is proud to have built and donated:


- The Rotary Gazebo in Kingsland Park, which is used by many groups;

Membership in a Rotary club is by invitation. Rotarians should be business owners, professionals, managers, retirees or community leaders.

Clubs meet weekly for fellowship and interesting and informative programs dealing with topics of local and global importance.

Rotarians must attend 50% of meetings to remain in good standing. To maintain this percentage, they can attend meetings at any Rotary club throughout the world, or by participating in a project that Rotary sponsors. Members should plan to attend at least 30% of meetings in their home club. Online options are available also.

Visit our Nutley Rotary Club and get to know us. If you choose to join, your Rotary sponsor will submit you for consideration for membership. Your name will be published twice in our online Newsletter.

If everything goes smoothly, a member of the Membership Committee will call you to arrange a date for your orientation to the Club and your induction.
