BUSINESS MEETING REPORT:

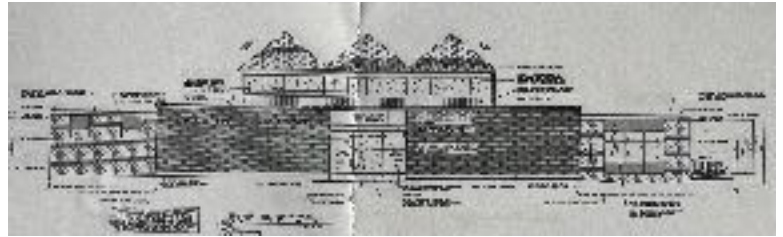

PROGRAM: LINCOLN PARK LIBRARY - Wayne Odenbrett, Library Board Chairman

Two weeks ago, Wayne, at left with President Patty, explained the current project to both expand and modernize the Lincoln Park Library. It was designed and built in the late 1960's and has not seen an upgrade since. Under their Borough budget rules, the library board was able to reserve 10% of their annual budget for future capital needs and had accumulated a significant reserve. Recently new state

funding for library capital needs was passed and they were able to move forward on a 50% matching funds basis. The \$1.1 million project was awarded the grant because they had their dollar share and the plans were ready. They will begin construction during the 2022, based upon plans developed by our member architect, Jim Cutillo.
