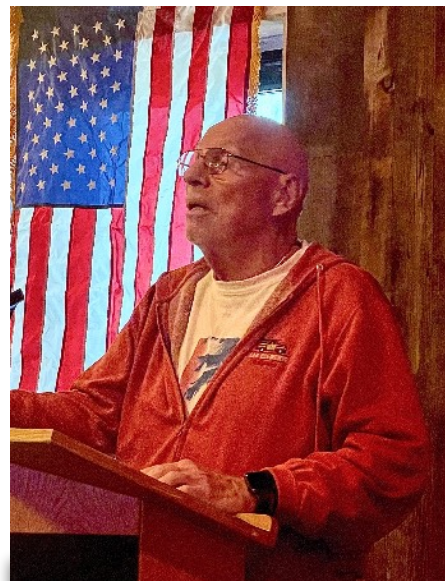
Rotary calendar lottery; Kathleen Pennington H5\$ For the golf outing , she won’t be there due to scheduled vacation before the postponement.
