Mr. Albert retired as a Lieutenant Colonel from the U.S. Air Force in 1998 after managing several of the largest communications and computer centers in the world. After retiring from the Air Force, Mr. Albert became a senior healthcare executive serving as Vice-President and Chief Information Officer (CIO) for four leading healthcare systems in CT and MA and was awarded New England Healthcare CIO of the Year.
